Refuse • Explain • Avoid • Leave

Learn how to say "NO" to drugs with emphasis on resistance strategies:

(R)efuse to use substances,
(E)xplain why you do not want to use substances, **(A)void** situations in which substances are used,
(L)eave situations in which substances are used.

Learn how to break the chain between drug use and abuse.

8th-12th Grade
12 sessions for 40-50 minutes
Tobacco-cessation strategies
Exercises to motivate against substance abuse

Opioid Education and Narcan Distribution

Learn what opioids are, the effects, the epidemic in SC, the impact it has in Fairfield, and what is being done to combat opioid misuse

Narcan distribution presentations include describing the risk factors for opioid overdose, identify the signs and symptoms of an opioid overdose, and demonstrate knowledge of how to respond to an opioid overdose

Life Skills Training

Reduces the risks of alcohol, tobacco, drug abuse, and violence by targeting the major social and psychological factors that promote the initiation of substance use and other risky behaviors.

3rd-10th Grade
10 sessions for 45-60 minutes
Pre and Post assessments

Tobacco Education Program

An alternative to penalties for students who face suspension for violation of a school tobacco use policy and for young people who break one of the state's laws regarding underage tobacco use.

9th-10th grade
4 hour program
