

# KNOW Overdose



## OVERDOSE SYMPTOMS

unconsciousness  
unresponsiveness  
slow breathing  
slow heartbeat  
muscle spasms or  
seizures

limp body  
blue-ish lips or nails  
slurred speech  
vomiting  
gurgling/death rattle

## HOW TO RESPOND

1. Identify overdose.
2. **Call 911 immediately!**
3. Administer Naloxone.
4. Begin rescue breaths/CPR.
5. Stay until EMS arrives.

### DO

Support breathing  
Give Naloxone  
Recovery position  
Keep warm until  
EMS arrives

### DON'T

Forcefully stimulate  
Put in a cold bath or  
shower  
Inject with any  
substance  
Induce vomiting

# GOOD SAMARITAN LAW

Provides criminal immunity to a person whom in good faith tries to reverse an overdose by administering Narcan or calls 911 to assist someone who is overdosing in an effort to save their life.

# SAVE LIVES USE NARCAN

Naloxone (Narcan) can help save the life of someone who is experiencing an opioid overdose. Narcan can not cause any harm if administered for an overdose that isn't opiate related or administered in the wrong dosage.
