



## WHAT'S IN YOUR MEDICINE CABINET?

*1 in 4 people who are prescribed opioids struggle with addiction.*

### OPIOIDS

Opioids are a class of highly addictive drugs used to reduce pain. They include prescription drugs like oxycodone, hydrocodone, morphine and fentanyl as well as illegal drugs like heroin.

*Opioid dependency can develop in just 3 Days.*

### STIMULANTS

Stimulants speed up mental and physical processes. Some of the most commonly abused stimulants include cocaine, methamphetamine, and prescription stimulants, like Ritalin and Adderall.

*1 in 4 teens have misused or abused RX drugs*

### THE RISKS

Opioids & Stimulants are commonly misused/abused due to their euphoric effects. As a person's tolerance is increased they will need more to feel the same effects which can lead to addiction, overdose, and even death.

*2 in 3 teens/young adults who've abused RX drugs reported getting it from friends or family.*

## MONITOR

Keep up with how many pills you have taken and know how many remain in the bottle.



## SECURE

Keep prescription medication in a secure locked location and avoid having loose pills laying around.
