VISION To be the lead authority in providing prevention, treatment, and recovery services for youth and adults in Fairfield County.

PRIMARY GOALS

- Delay onset of youth drug use and promote healthy and safe living through prevention activities;
- Improve emotional, behavioral and social functioning;
- *Reduce* substance use, *increase* sobriety, and *sustain* recovery that produces better outcomes; and
- Prevent/reduce frequency and severity of recurrence

HISTORY

- Operating since 1973
- Sole county authority for substance use services
- 1 of 32 authorities statewide
- 501 (c) (3) Public nonprofit organization

CLIENTELE

- About 250-300 clients *served* yearly in treatment (*with priority admission for pregnant women/IV drug users*) and 2500 in prevention services
- **Referrals:** Self, Probation, Courts, Solicitors, DJJ, Schools, DSS, Mental Health, DMV, and others
- Appointments scheduled Monday – Thursday.
