

EMS and Coroners Provide overdose reversals and deaths, along with their location, suspected drug, patient demographics and if Narcan was administered


FCSD and WPS Provide information regarding alcohol, opioid and stimulant related arrest and drug seizures


Fairfield County EMS Opioid Overdose Reversals & Deaths




Overdose Deaths

2023 Overdose By Race/Gender







2024 Overdoses by Race/Gender



Opioid Related Overdoses By Age







Opioid Overdoses by Location




<u>According to the FY23 SC County-Level Profiles on Substance</u> <u>Use-Related Indicators Rank 1 - 46 = worst to best:</u>

Fairfield ranked <u>1st</u> and worst county in the state for *EMS Naloxone Administrations* for the last four (4) years. There was no change in ranking since 2022 for *Opioid Prescriptions Dispensed* at <u>42nd</u> and overall Opioid *Domain* at <u>23rd</u> for 2023. However, the *Opioid-Involved Overdose Deaths* got slightly worst from <u>39th</u> in 2022 to <u>36th</u> in 2023 by 47.18%. Considerable improvement was made with *Opioid-Related Hospitalizations* from <u>6th</u> in 2022 to <u>13th</u> in 2023 though still on the worst end of the spectrum.


