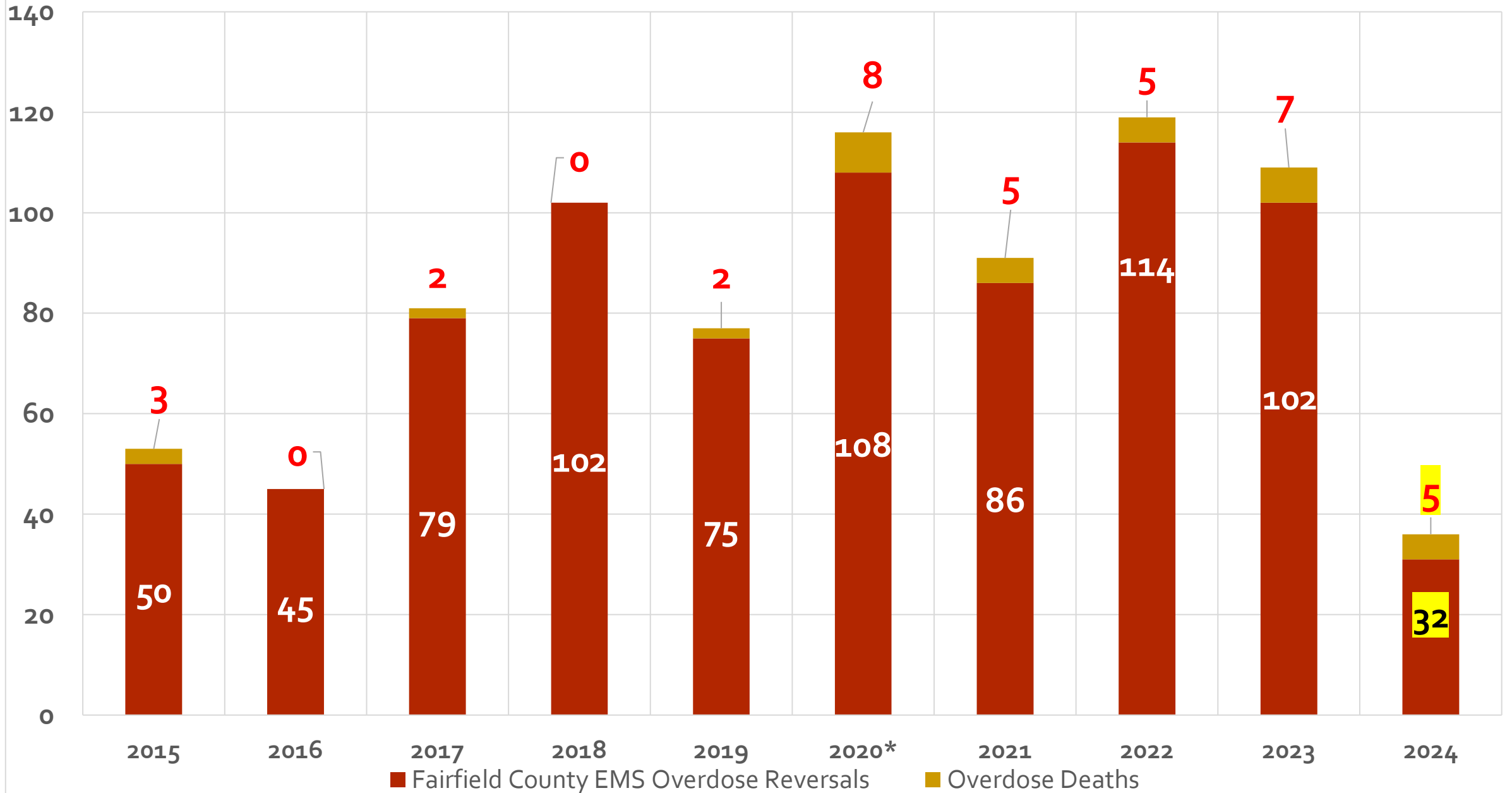

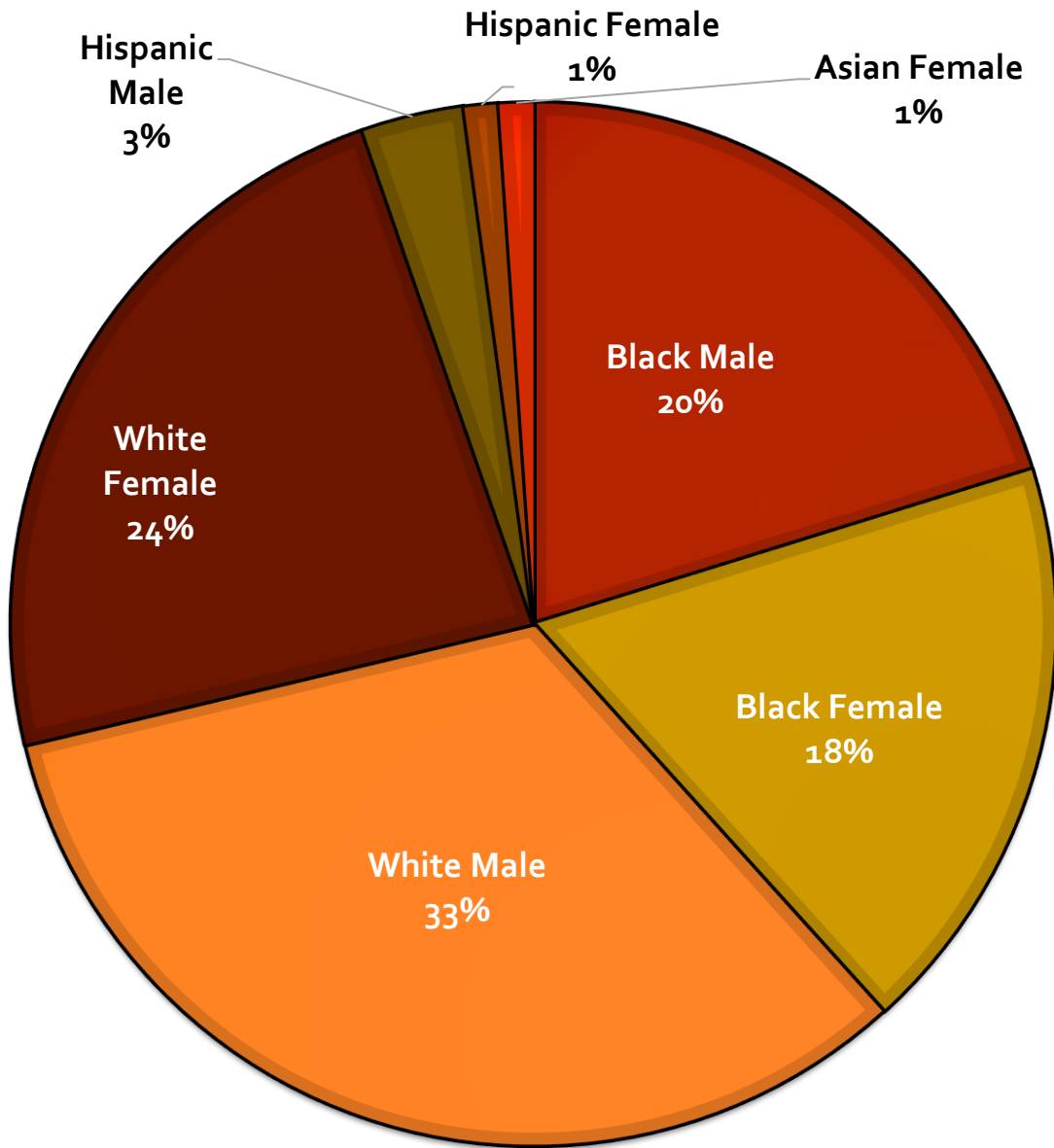

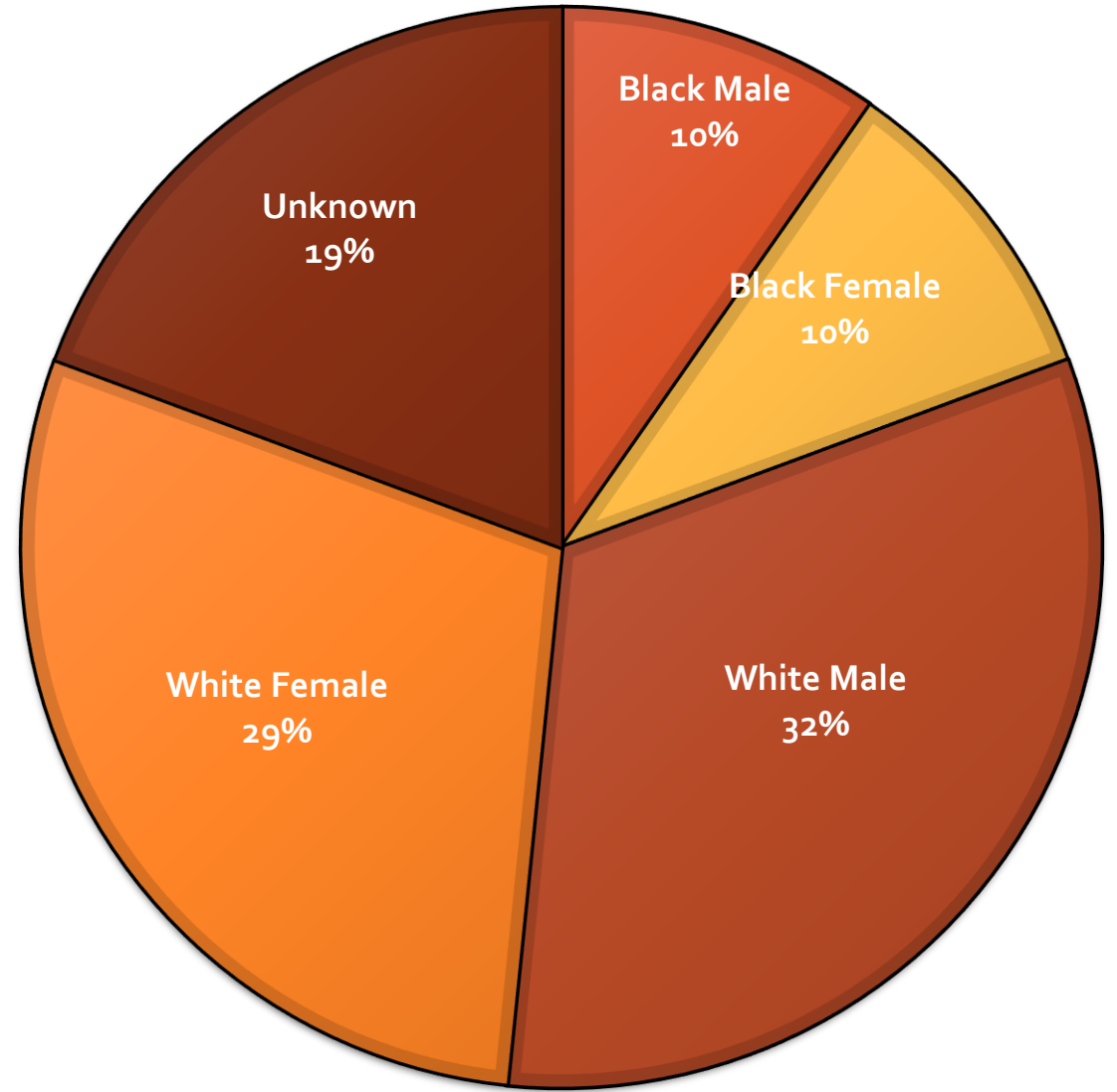


2023 Overdose By Race/Gender



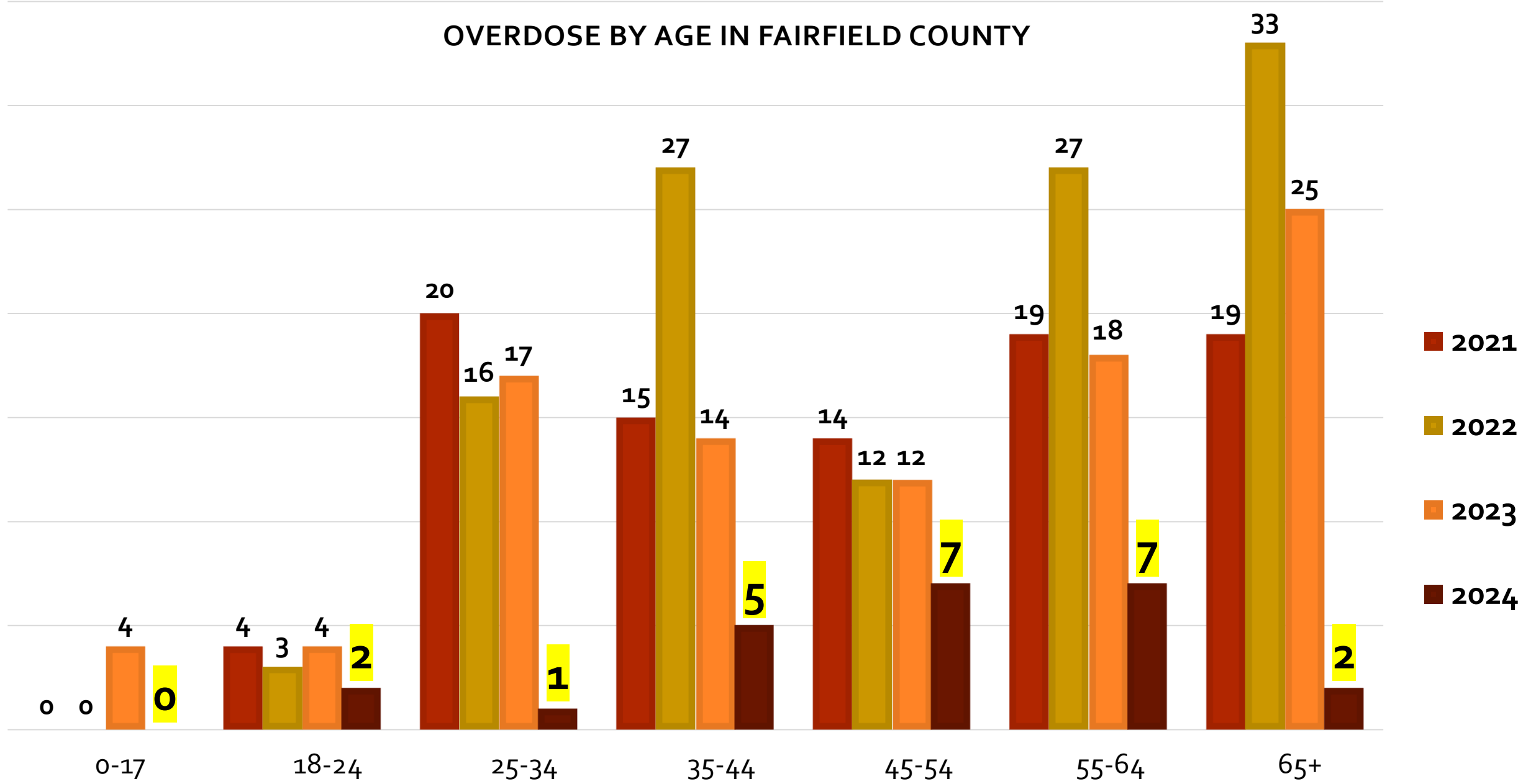

2024 Overdoses by Race/Gender



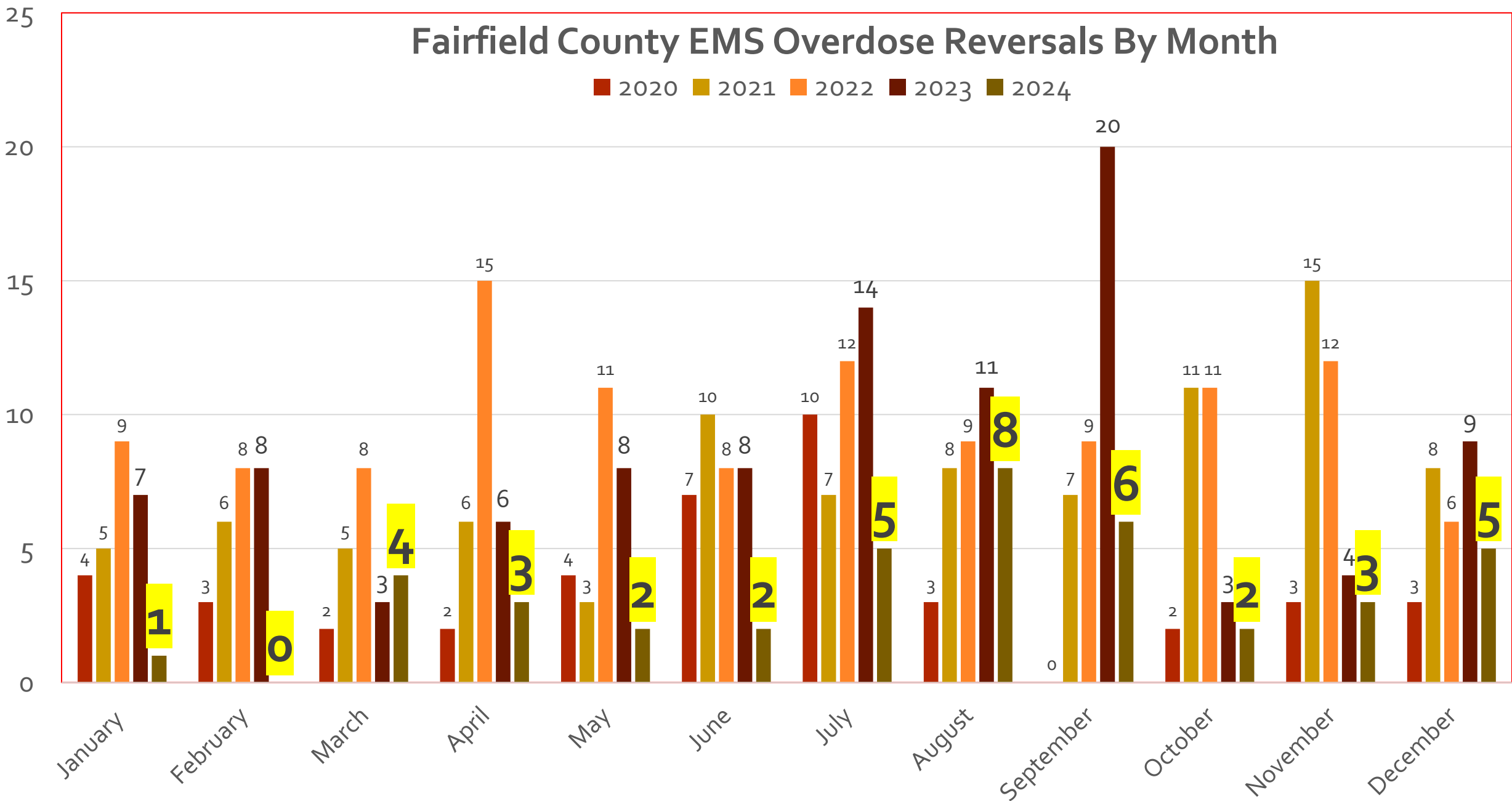

OVERDOSE BY AGE IN FAIRFIELD COUNTY

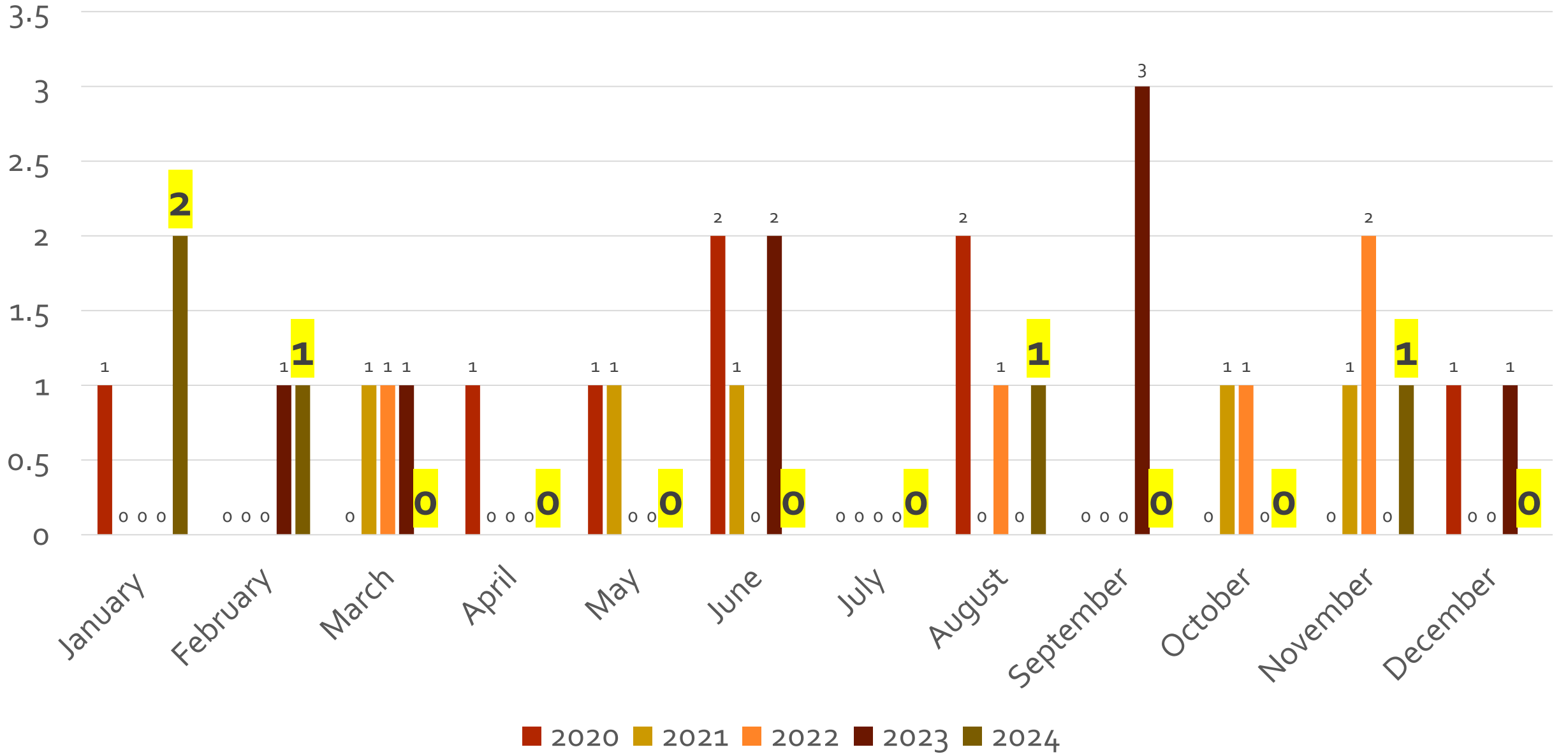


Fairfield County EMS Overdose Reversals By Month

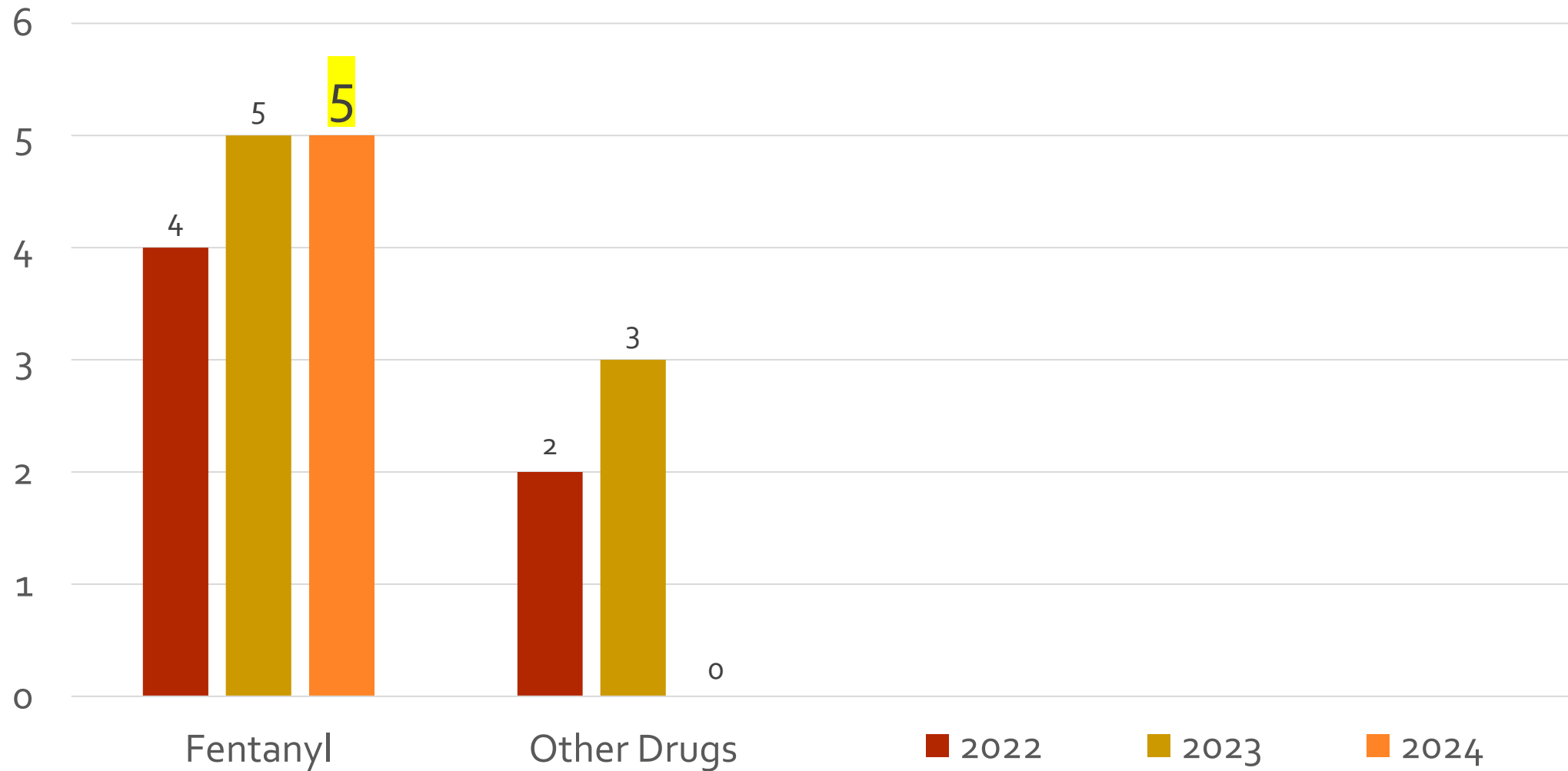

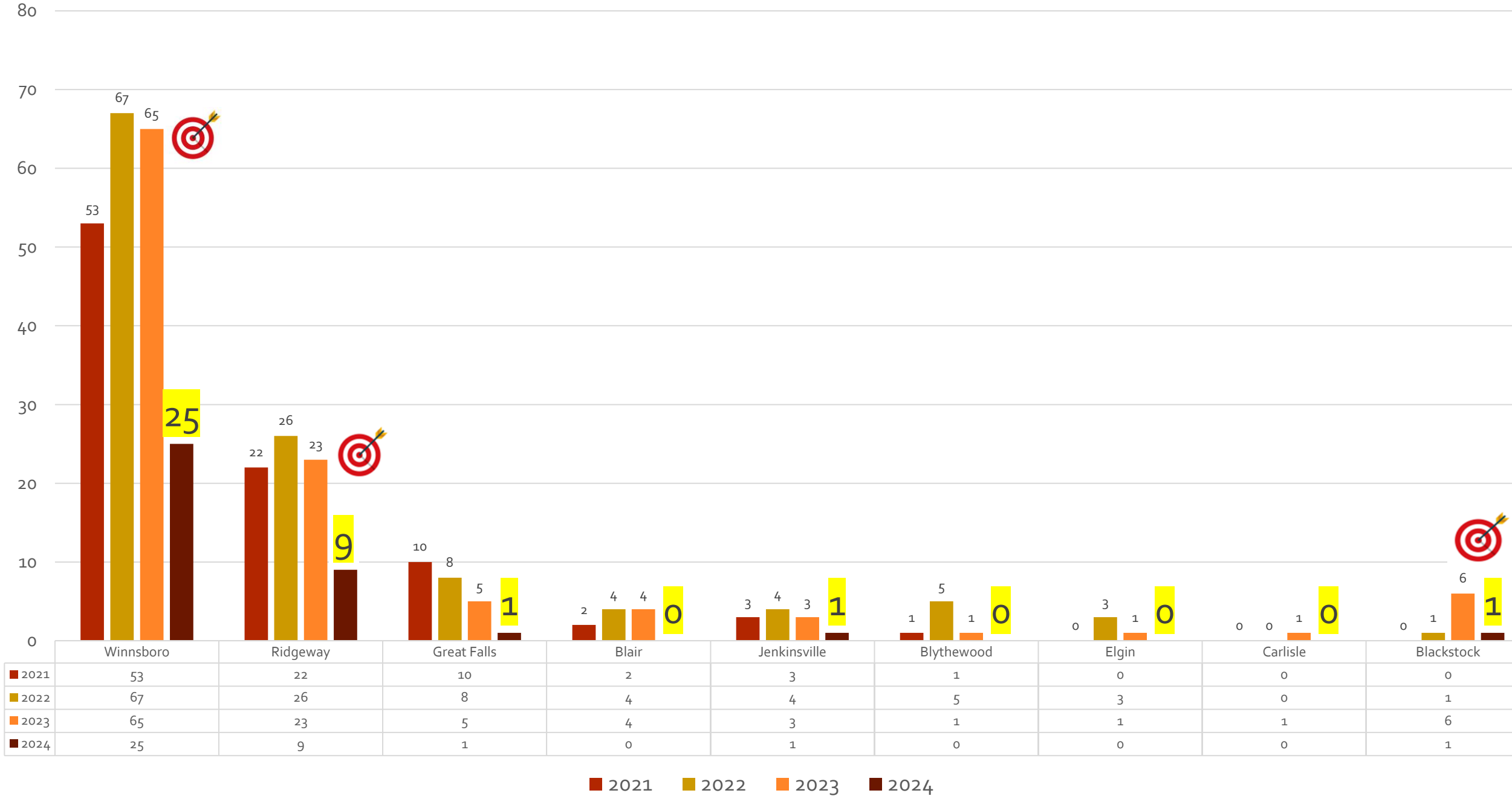
Fairfield County Overdose Deaths



Overdose Deaths by Type

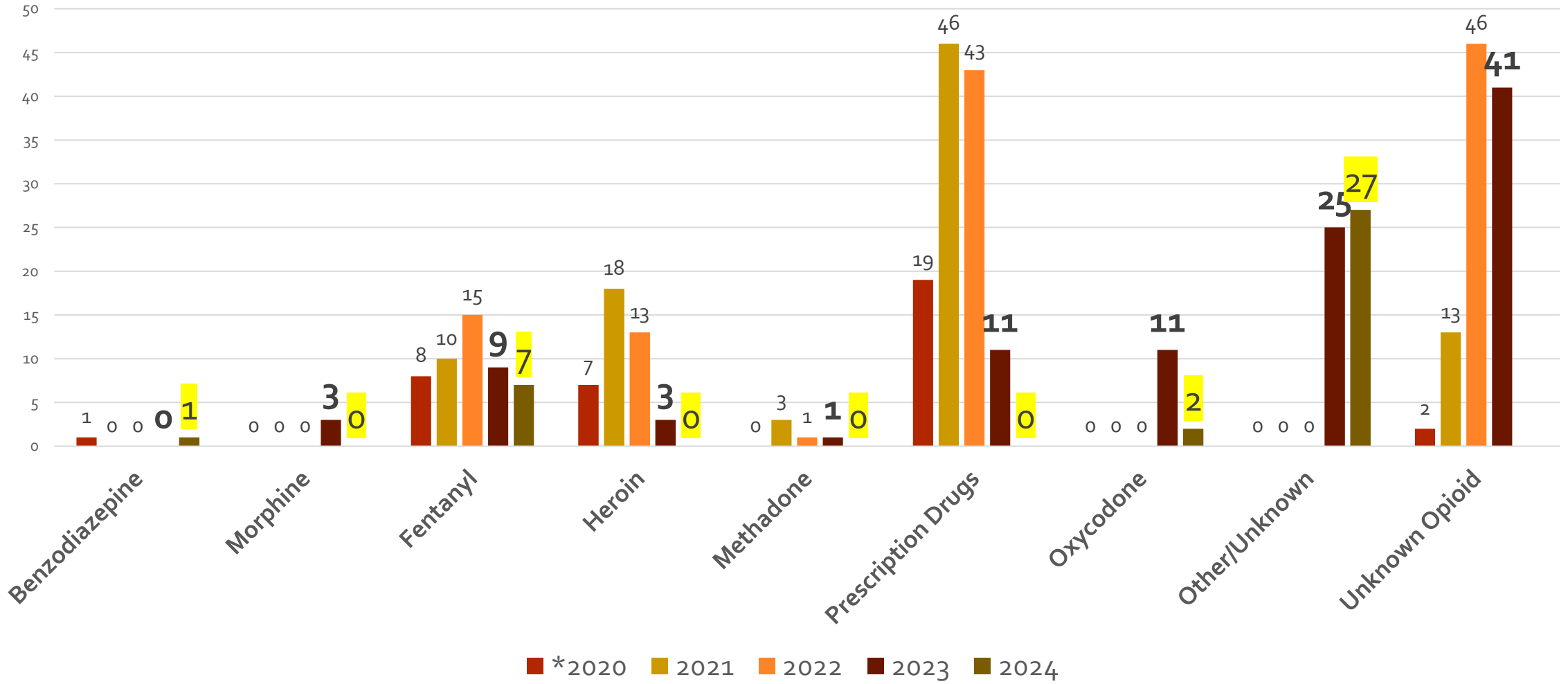


2021-2024 Overdose Locations in Fairfield County

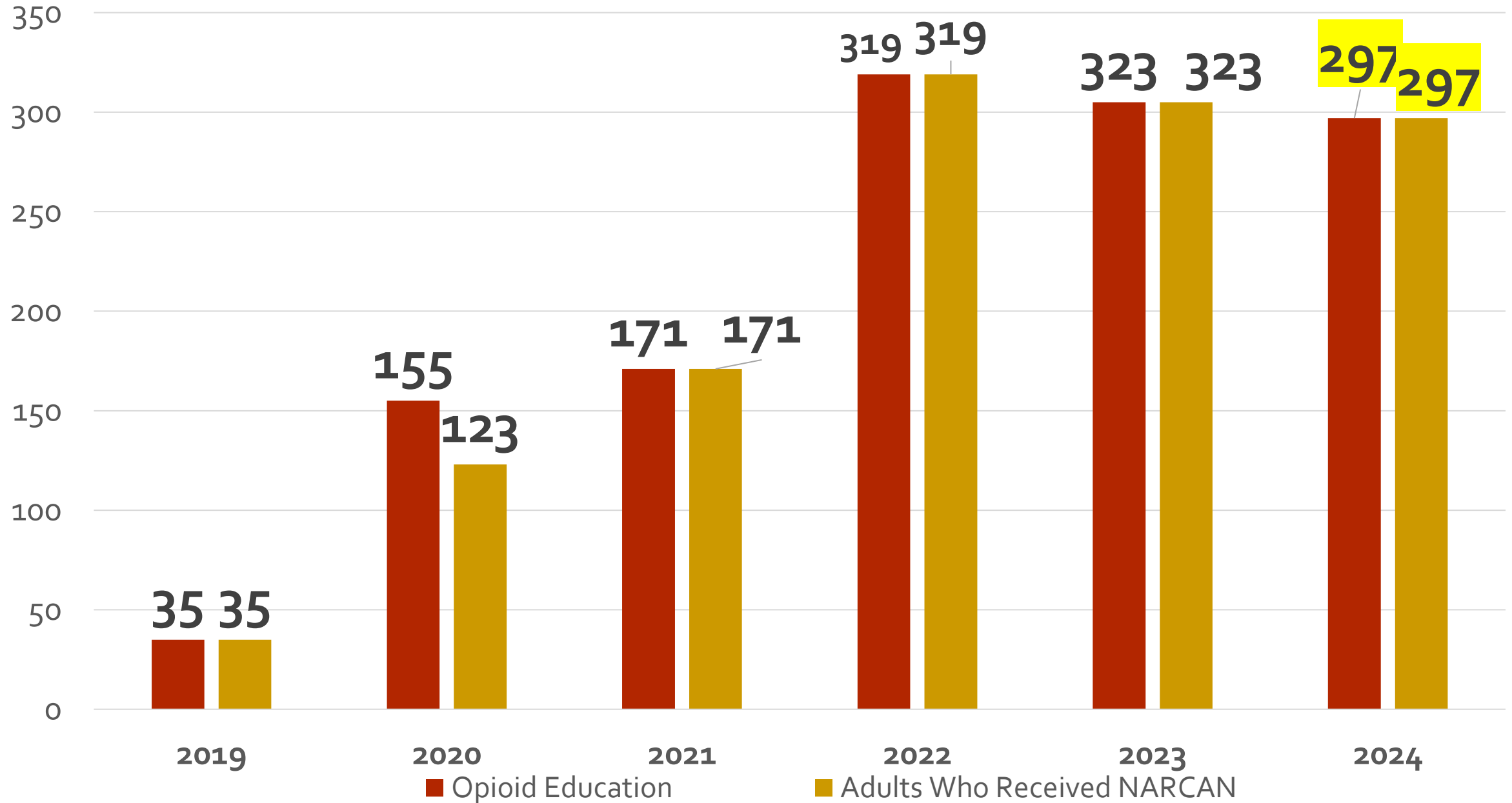

2020-2024 Primary Drugs Suspected in Overdoses



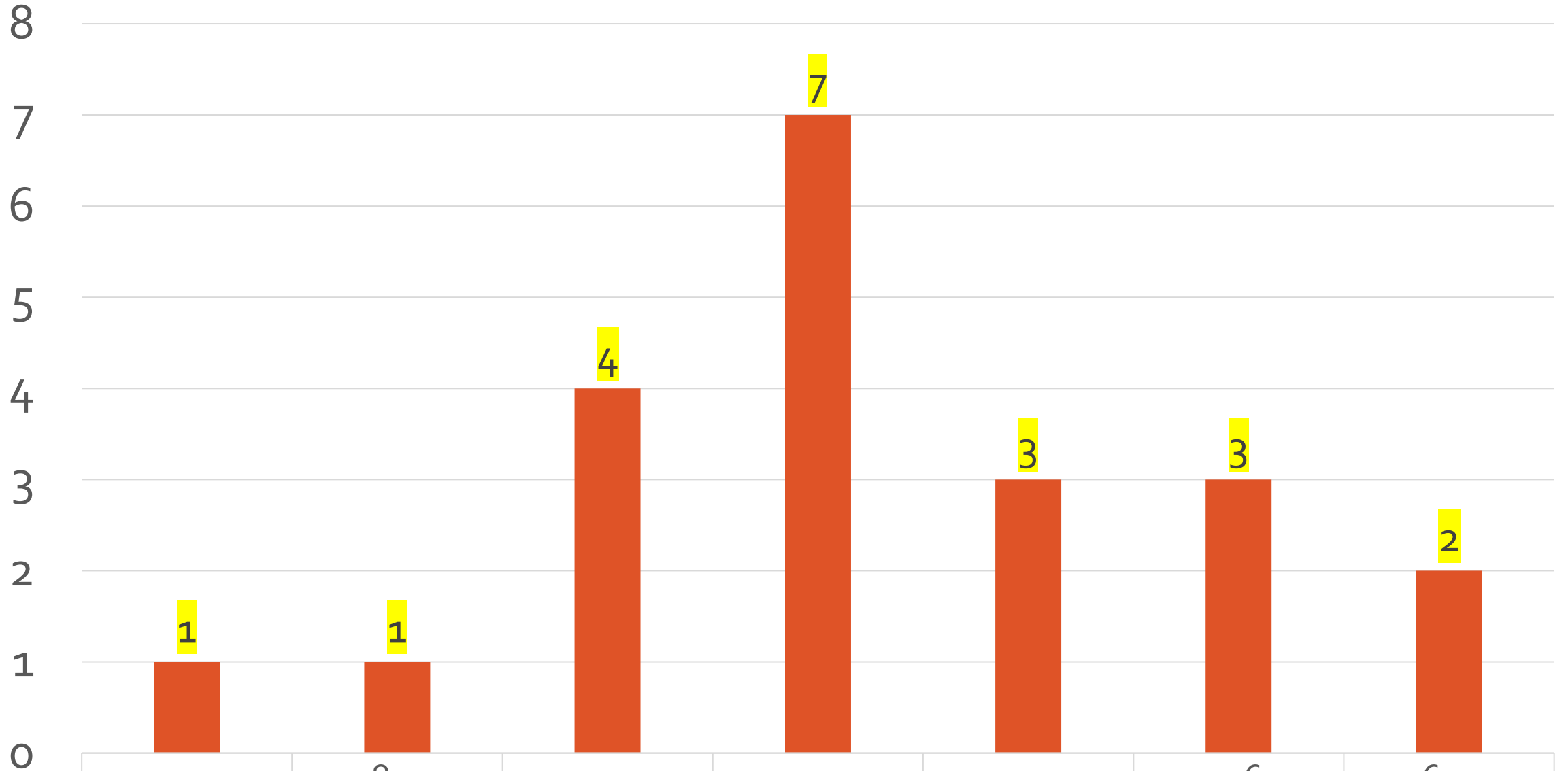

2024 EMS Alcohol Data by Age

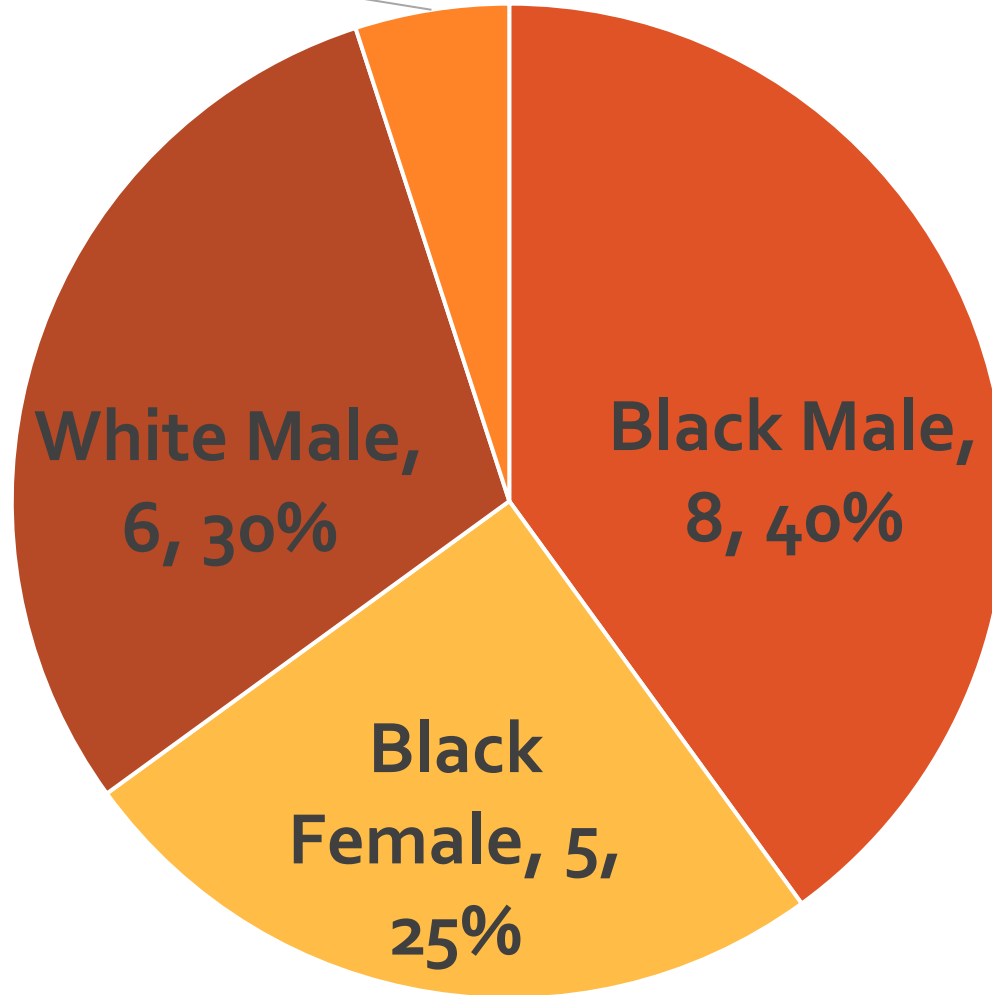

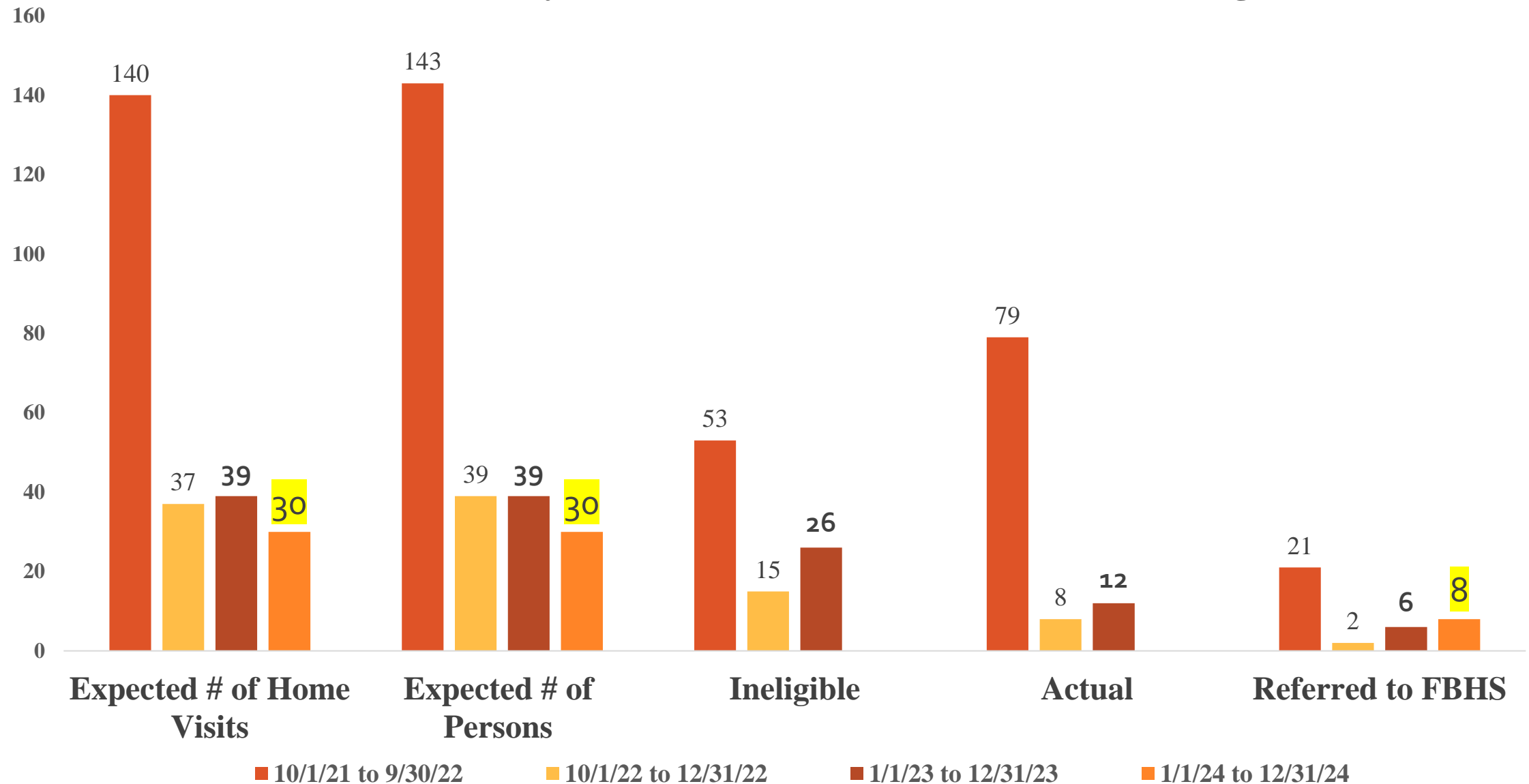

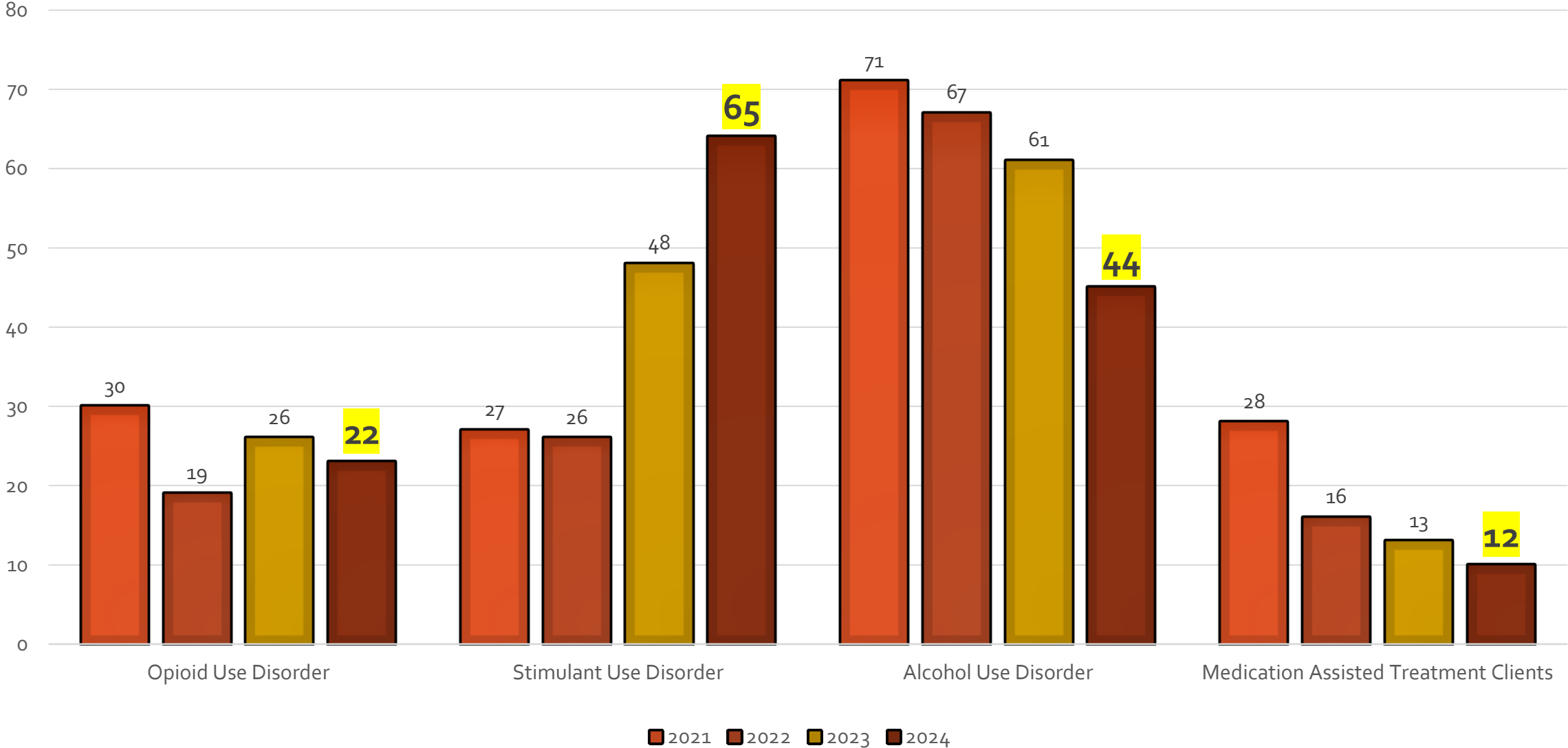
